DRUG SITUATION & PREVALENCE

- **YOUTH PREVALENCE:** According to the Ohio Student Survey for 2001-2002, the average percentage statewide using marijuana in the past year among 6th, 8th, 10th, and 12th graders is 18.3%; 3.2% for past year cocaine use, and 4.4% for past year inhalant use.
- **ARRESTEES:** Cincinnati does not collect urinalysis data on the arrestee population.
- **DEATHS:** Drug-induced deaths remained stable from 72 in 1995 to 71 in 1998 (4.5 to 4.4 deaths per 100,000 population).
- **ER MENTIONS:** Cincinnati does not collect emergency department drug episode data.
