DRUG SITUATION & PREVALENCE

- **YOUTH PREVALENCE:** Tampa does not collect data on youth drug use prevalence.
- **ARRESTEES:** Tampa does not collect urinalysis data on the arrested population.
- **DEATHS:** Drug-induced deaths in the PMSA increased 35% from 108 in 1995 to 146 in 1998 (5.0 to 6.5 deaths per 100,000 population).
- **ER MENTIONS:** Tampa does not collect data on drug emergency department episodes.
- **DRUG TYPE:** Cocaine, heroin (primarily South American), and marijuana pose the most significant drug threats to Tampa. Other dangerous drugs such as MDMA, GHB and its analogs, and diverted pharmaceuticals increasingly are available and abused.

TREATMENT UTILIZATION & CAPACITY

- 22 treatment providers located in the Tampa PMSA;

- Tampa has three (3) drug courts in operation: pretrial, post adjudication and juvenile. A family drug court is in the planning stages.

- During 2001, there were 4,173 drug/narcotic offenses known to Tampa police.
